**Sabina Petrucci (Fiom-Cgil): "Success of the Electrolux European action day. Now it's necessary company expresses a real will to overcome the problems"**

*Sabina Petrucci, IndustriaAll coordinator of the Ewc Electrolux, released the following statement.*

"It was a success the Electrolux European action day called by the European Works Council delegates, with the participation of all the trade unions of the countries involved."

"In addition to the initiatives carried out in the Italian plants – which will continue tomorrow, with the protest outside the headquarters of the Swedish consulate (closed today) by the workers of the Solaro (Milan) plant – there have been a lot of initiatives in all European plants."

"In particular there have been held meetings, demonstrations, leaflets and billboard posters, with the aim to inform and engage more extensively as possible the workers in all the plants in Germany, Poland, Hungary, Sweden, Netherlands, Spain, UK and France."

"Now we expect Electrolux give different answers to the Ewc delegates than those provided until now. Responses that correspond to a real will of the company to overcome the industrial problems and the workers' concerns."

"In the coming days, with the involvement of IndustriaAll, we will decide, together with the delegates, how to take forward our demands and our protests."
